





STRATFORD DESTINATION ANIMATION PROJECT RETURNS WITH A LOCAL FUNDING OPPORTUNITY AND A NEW NAME

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(Stratford, ON) The former Destination Animation Project (DAP) has returned for 2022, its 7th year and has since been renamed: Destination Development Fund (DDF). With \$30,000 available funding again this year, DDF is seeking innovative applications for projects that develop and improve our destination for both residents and visitors. The application is open now at visitstratford.ca/ddf.

The Fund was established with investment from Regional Tourism Organization 4 (RT04), Downtown Stratford BIA and Destination Stratford, to enable and support feasible projects that are highly shareable and impactful for the destination. The selected projects directly align with Stratford's cultural DNA and strengthen the destination's experiences and storytelling opportunities.

In 2021, DDF received an overwhelming response in applications with 24 submissions totaling over \$120,000 requested. With their collective \$38,000, the funding partners supported 12 cultural projects with funding to help strengthen Stratford's rich cultural experiences.

Organizations eligible for funding include:

- Tourism enterprises and businesses (as individual organizations or as a consortium) with interests in arts & culture, heritage, agri-culinary, sports, meetings & conventions, etc.
- Festivals and Events
- For-profit or non-profit organizations.

Applicants can apply with 2022 projects for a range of support for new tourism-related experiences, enhancements to existing tourism-related experiences (in-person or digital, projects that improve the visitor experience), PPE and physical hygiene measures, and/or storytelling (capturing of content - photo/video and/or social media). Applicants are welcome to submit multiple applications for different projects.

Individual applications can apply for funding from \$500 to \$10,000. Applications close April 14th at 5:00 P.M.
